



Revitalize Festival 2022

1. WELCOME

Drive through parking area and park carefully please. Walk to end of parking area, to get your essential festival mask and map. We wish you an enjoyable time here. The following information addresses a few necessary rules & information.

2. TOILETS

There is a flushable women's toilet in The Hub ('Sharing' shed). There are also two unisex port-o-loos near the carpark entrance. There is a further Gents loo around the back of the shed. Follow the signs.

3. COVID-19

We will be following all current laws pertaining to running an event during the pandemic. In particular this means that we are required to scan all vaccine passports for adults and children over 12. We ask that if you are sick on the day, that you stay home. A mask must be worn by all persons over the age of 12 when inside the 'Sharing' shed/the Hub, unless you have an official exemption. We will supply a concert mask to each ticket-holder to keep and wear as this is your lanyard and must be seen so we know you have paid and come through Vaccine passport check, thank you.

4. NATURAL HAZARDS

Please look at the map showing where everything is. Keep away from areas not marked on the map, as there are known hazards on the property, such as large rocks, under-runners, ditches, holes, banks and ponds. Keep out of the animal paddocks, they can be dangerous!

5. This is a working farm and has a health and safety plan. Unless on a guided walk, please stay in areas marked on the map, as there are known hazards on the property. These include large rocks, under-runners, ditches, holes, banks, ponds and creeks. At all times watch out for animals, and vehicles. Drivers please keep your speed down and watch out for children. Please keep children away from the generators or electrical supply to the food trucks.

6. All who enter, must make themselves familiar with known hazards, stay in the area of this map provided at entry, follow and observe all signs, stay on or within the marked tracks/areas. Please wear clothing and footwear suited to the day's climatic conditions.

7. The Emergency Assembly Area is up the hill above stage & below camping area.

8. No dogs, drugs, or firearms are permitted on the property, nor in vehicles. You're welcome to bring a full picnic hamper but drunken behaviour is strongly discouraged, and may result in your removal from the property without refund, regardless of whether you agree that you are drunk.

9. The organisers of Revitalize reserve the right to request any person to immediately leave the property, and if that person refuses to leave, they will be deemed a trespasser and will be removed from the property.
